Home Care

We provide home care services for children, young people and adults, helping them to live as independently as possible in the safety and comfort of familiar surroundings. At Banquo we tailor all packages of care and support to meet the unique needs of the individual, whether they are recovering from illness, require ongoing complex care, or need temporary support, Banquo offers the support to meet those needs. All of our support workers are trained to uphold continuity, promote independence, and maintain daily routines, ensuring that care is delivered in a way that enhances quality of life and independent living.

Day Time Visits

Support workers can visit for a few hours each day to provide assistance with personal care, household tasks, meal preparation, and social engagement. These visits can be arranged at times that suit your routine, ensuring you get the help you need without disrupting your lifestyle.

Night Care

How It Works

1

Step One: Understanding individual needs

At the point of referral, whether through a commissioner, family member or other source, we would try to gather as much information about the individual as possible so we can assess if we are able to meet their individual needs.

2

Step Two: Development of a child/person-centered care and support plan

Once a package has been agreed, one of our care team will visit the individual needing the care and support in order to develop a child/person-centered care and support plan.

3

Step Three: Find the perfect support worker(s)

Once the care plan has been developed the care team will allocate support workers to provide the care and support required. This is done through skills matching and looking at geographical location.

4

Step Four: Introducing support workers

Once we have allocated the support workers, where possible we will arrange an introductory visit so you can meet the individual requiring the care and support. This is not always possible, so in these cases we will inform the individual, or their advocate, who will be coming and what time they will arrive.

5

Step Five: Commencement of support

On an agreed day and time Banquo will commence with the care and support agreed as part of the commission and care planning process.

6

Step Six: Maintaining communication

Our care team will stay in contact with the person being supported or their advocate throughout their care and support journey to ensure everything is going smoothly and the needs of the service user are being met.

7

Step Seven: Ongoing support

Banquo's care team operates 24/7 in order to provide full support even out of hours. Should any incidents or emergencies occur our team are on hand to assist and advise.

8

Step Eight: Reviewing and adapting

Once the care and support has commenced our care team will ask for regular feedback from service users, families and support workers to ensure all needs are being met effectively. If any changes to the care and support are required, this will be actioned.

No matter your situation, Banquo's dedicated team of support staff work closely with families, schools, and Local Authorities to ensure every individual receives the right level of care and support for their unique circumstances.
